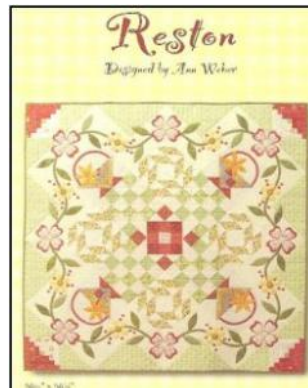


Saturday Morning Club

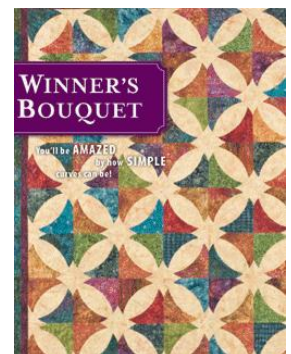

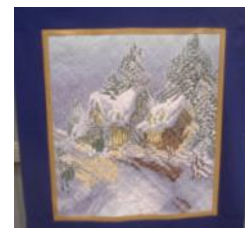
